

THE 2014 BRUSSELS STUDY TOUR: THE EUROPEAN UNION

Dates of travel

Leave for Brussels on Fri, May 23
Return to the U.S. on Sat, May 31

What will we do in Brussels?

We will visit the institutions of the European Union, including the European Parliament, and attend briefing sessions. In addition we will also visit the offices of various NGOs. Most of these briefings will occur in the morning and afternoon, with evenings largely free for exploring the city of Brussels. A complete schedule of events will be provided before the trip.



Can I get course credit for the study tour?

Yes. The study tour is an integral part of *EC280 International Organizations Seminar*. The course is offered in the spring semester, and will meet once a week, on Mondays, at 11:00 am. You can register for one of two sections: EC280A (2 credits) or EC280B (3 credits). The 3-credit version will count as an economics elective—it will satisfy one of the elective requirements for an economics major, economics minor or a business administration minor.

How much will the study tour cost?

The program fee is \$1,990. The fee covers roundtrip airfare from the U.S. to Brussels, lodging in Brussels, and travel from the hotel to various organizations. Other expenses—food, entertainment, additional travel, etc.—are the student's responsibility. No additional tuition is required.

A deposit of \$200 is necessary to hold your place.
