From 1799 to 1812, Lancaster was the capital of Pennsylvania. Lancaster and Lancaster County have been the home of prominent historical figures, including President James Buchanan, Congressman Thaddeus Stevens, and Robert Fulton. Lancaster is home to approximately 56,000 residents, where historic preservation and a cutting-edge arts scene live and thrive side by side.
