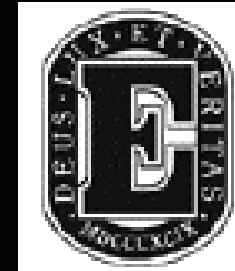

Dr. Susan Traverso currently serves as the Provost and Senior Vice President of Elizabethtown College. As the chief academic officer of the college, Dr. Traverso is responsible for planning, implementing, and managing the

college's academic policies as well as for oversight of the College's academic expense budget. The Provost provides oversight for all personnel issues related to the educational program of the College and represents the administration on the Executive Council of the Faculty Assembly and represents the College in its relationship with the Brethren Colleges Abroad.

The author of "Welfare Politics in Boston, 1910-40," Traverso is an historian of urban politics and 20th-century social policy. Her book, published by the University of Massachusetts in 2003, explores the influence of ethnic politics on Boston's enlarging welfare programs. Traverso has also written on numerous topics in higher education and has presented at several national conferences of higher education organizations.
