ED 105 A	Yes	ED 105 is required of Early Childhood majors. The course is open to all students interested in exploring Education as a potential major. All subsequent courses normally are for majors only
ED 106 A	Yes	ED 106 is required of the Elementary/Middle level and Secondary, Music, Art and Spanish majors. The course is open to all students interested in exploring Education as a potential major. All subsequent courses normally are for majors only
ED 150 A	Yes	ED 150 is required of Early Childhood Education majors. All students must select one of the fieldwork sections below.
ED 150 LA	Yes	<u>Early Childhood</u> students only should enroll in sections ED 150 LA.
ED 151 A	Yes	ED 151 is required of Elementary/Middle level and Secondary, Music, Art and Spanish majors. All students must select one of the fieldwork sections below.
ED 151 LA	Yes	<u>Elementary /Middle level and Secondary majors</u> students only should enroll in sections ED 151 LA.
ED 161A	Yes	Strongly recommended elective for all students who desire training in instructional technology at introductory level.
ED 162A	Yes	Strongly recommended elective for all students who desire more advanced training in current instructional technology.
ED 214	Yes	ED 214 is required of the Early Childhood major. Prerequisite is ED 150 or ED 151.
ED 226	Yes	ED 226 is required of the Elementary/Middle Level major. Prerequisites are ED 105 and ED 150 or ED 106 and ED 151.
ED 241 A	Yes	Required of all Early Childhood, Elementary/Middle and Secondary, Music, Art and Spanish Education students. Prerequisites are ED 105 and ED 150 or ED 106 and ED 151.
ED 250 A	Yes	Early Childhood Education only. Prerequisites are ED 105 and ED 150.
ED 258 A	Yes	Required of all Early Childhood, Elementary/Middle majors. Prerequisites are ED 105 or ED 106 and ED 150 or 151 and ED 250.
SED 272 A	Yes	SED 272 is a requirement of Early Childhood and Elementary/Middle level. Prerequisites are ED 105 and ED 150 or ED 106 or ED 151.
SED 282 A B	Yes	Required of all Early Childhood, Elementary/Middle and Secondary, Music, Art and Spanish Education students. Prerequisites are ED 105 and ED 150 or ED 106 and ED 151.
SED 285 A	Yes	SED 285 is part of the Early Childhood w Special Education concentration and Elementary/Middle w/Special Education concentration. Prerequisite is ED 250 or ED 251 and SED 282. Corequisites: SED 290 and SED 293.
SED 290 A	Yes	SED 290 is part of the Early Childhood w Special Education concentration and Elementary/Middle w/Special Education concentration. Prerequisite is Ed 250 or ED 251 and SED 282. Corequisites: SED 285 and SED 293.
SED 293 A	Yes	SED 293 is part of the Early Childhood w Special Education concentration and Elementary/Middle w/Special Education concentration. Prerequisite is ED 250 or ED 251 and SED 282. Corequisites: SED 290 and SED 293
ED 305 EN	Yes	Secondary English Education majors only. Prerequisites ED 106 and ED 151
ED 326 A ED 336 A ED 346 A ED 366 A	Yes	Elementary/Middle majors only. ED 326, 336, 346, 366 (Junior Block) are taken concurrently. Offered spring semester only
ED 360	Yes	ED 360 is a requirement of the Early Childhood major. Prerequisite is ED 250.
ED 400 A	Yes	Only students accepted for and working toward Honors in the Discipline in Education may enroll for this class experience

ED 490 is taken concurrently with ED 470.
ED 475 A	Yes	ED 475 is an alternative internship available.
ED 484 A	Yes	Independent Study in Education
ED 490 A	Yes	Senior Elementary Education majors should enroll in section A. Taken concurrently with ED 470.
ED 490 B	Yes	Senior Secondary and Music, Art and Spanish Education majors should enroll in section B. Taken concurrently with ED 470.
ED 495 A	Yes	Senior Seminar for Early Childhood Education. Taken concurrently with ED 470 and ED 490.
ED 496 A	Yes	Senior Seminar for Elementary/Middle Education. Taken concurrently with ED 470 and ED 490.
ED 497 A	Yes	Senior Seminar for Secondary, Art, Music and Spanish Education. Taken concurrently with ED 470 and ED 490.

Other Notes:

1. The overall grade point average in place at the time of Formal Acceptance into a certification program determines the GPA required to enroll in any 300-level Education course and to qualify for certification. The level required is 3.0. First year students will be held to the 2.8 standard for their first year and Provisional Acceptance, but will need to be at or above 3.0 to gain formal acceptance.
2. Students wishing to enroll in classes beyond the 100 level must at least have Provisional Acceptance into their certification program or be making application for it at the end of the current semester.
3. Registration of all ED prefix courses will take place in the Education office, Room 143 in Nicarry Hall from 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM. It will begin November 9th. **Watch the bulletin board near the Education Office for more details.** Students' advising holds must be lifted by their advisor, so students should schedule their advising appointments early.
