Please note change of status from resident to commuter may affect financial aid package

**All students wishing to change from a residential student to a commuter must submit the following documentation for status change consideration:**

- The completed change of status application
- The attached form mailed from parents home address  
(home address must be in within a 30 mile radius of the college)

*As stated in the online student handbook, "Students who wish to obtain commuter status must submit to the Office of Residence Life a signed letter from the family member with whom they plan to live. The letter must include the address and telephone number of the student's intended residence. **The College may further verify the student's intentions.** Misrepresentation of one's commuter status is considered a violation of the College's Residency Agreement, as well as the Social Conduct System (i.e., furnishing false information to a College official). When such violations occur, judicial action will be taken and sanctions levied*
