About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays fell to hot-shooting Albright 93-80 on Wednesday night in Reading, as the Lions shot 60.4 percent from the field and canned 10 three-pointers in the victory. Junior C **Mike Church** led the Blue Jays with 15 points and seven rebounds while junior F **Josh Houseal** scored a career-high 14 points... Last Saturday, the Blue Jays downed Messiah 71-59 behind a career-high 23 points from sophomore G/F **Joe Flanagan** while sophomore G **Keith Fogel** matched his career high with 21 points. The Blue Jays went 21-for-36 (58.3 percent) from the field for the game including 11-for-17 (64.7 percent) in the second half... Flanagan was named the Commonwealth Conference Player of the Week after averaging 21.0 points and 6.0 rebounds in two victories last week. He has scored in double figures in 14 of Etown's 15 games this season... Fogel has made 21 consecutive foul shots over the last nine games, and leads the conference in free-throw percentage at 91.7 percent (33-for-36)... Church leads the conference in blocked shots per game at 1.6 (24 in 15 games) while senior G **Phil Schaffer** is tops in the league in assists with an average of 4.67 per game... The Blue Jays committed a season-low six turnovers at Albright, their lowest total since Feb. 14, 2007 at Messiah (5).

About Widener...

The Pride lost 60-53 at Lycoming on Sunday afternoon, rallying from a 12-point deficit with 3:35 left to tie the score in the final minute only to see the Warriors score the final seven points. Junior G **Bobby Edmunds** led Widener with 14 points, but the Pride shot just 32.1 percent (18-for-56) from the field as a team and could not fully capitalize on 25 Warrior turnovers. The loss snapped a five-game winning streak by Widener, which had scored 80 or more points in each of the previous four games... The Pride opened conference play with a 91-63 rout of visiting Albright on Jan. 7, with Edmunds scoring 19 points and senior G **Charles Jones** adding 13 points... Jones leads the Commonwealth Conference in scoring with an average of 17.9 points per game, while senior F **Matt Sosna** leads the conference in field-goal percentage (65.0 percent, 78-for-120) and three-point percentage (51.7 percent, 15-for-29), is second in rebounding (7.6 per game) and sixth in scoring (14.7 ppg)... Senior G **Nyere Miller** has recorded 45 steals in 11 games, a conference-best average of 4.09 steals per game... Jones was a first-team All-Conference and second-team All-Region selection last season after averaging 15.7 points per game, while Edmunds was a second-team pick.
