About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays took care of Arcadia 72-58 on the road last Saturday, then moved into a tie for first place in the Commonwealth Conference when Widener lost at Lebanon Valley 85-75 on Wednesday night. Sophomore G **Keith Fogel** scored a career-high 25 points, including 18 in the second half, as the Blue Jays went 8-for-15 from three-point range as a team. Junior C **Mike Church** added 12 points, seven rebounds, four assists and four blocked shots while sophomore G **Mark Vogel** hit a pair of three-pointers and scored a season-high eight points off the bench... Fogel went 6-for-6 from the foul line against Arcadia and has made 27 consecutive foul shots. He leads the Commonwealth Conference in free-throw shooting at 92.9 percent (39-for-42)... Sophomore G/F **Joe Flanagan** ranks fourth in the conference in scoring at 14.7 points per game, and is second in three-point field-goal percentage at 44.2 percent (38-for-86), just behind Widener's Matt Sosna who is at 44.4 percent (20-for-45)... As he has been for nearly all of the last two seasons, Church is atop the conference in blocks per game at 1.67 (30 in 18 games)... The trio of Church, Flanagan and Fogel have scored in double figures 40 times among them, including eight games in which all three did it.

About Albright...

The Lions held on for an 86-78 win over Arcadia on Wednesday night as sophomore G **Zac Shaeffer** drained six three-pointers and scored a career-high 30 points. Senior C **Phil Hall** reached double figures for the 11th straight game as he added 14 points along with eight rebounds and five blocked shots for Albright. As a team, the Lions shot 53.8 percent (28-for-52) from the field including 12-for-22 from three-point range... Albright is 3-0 at home in conference play, but has gone 0-3 on the road including losses by 20 points at Lycoming and 28 points at Widener... Four Lions have connected on 17 or more three-pointers this season, led by 42 from Shaeffer and 20 by sophomore G **Matt Ashcroft** off the bench... Phil Hall ranks fifth in the conference in rebounds per game (6.9) and is second in field-goal percentage at 53.6 percent. He is also a three-point threat, having drilled three against Arcadia on Wednesday... Against the Blue Jays on Jan. 14, Phil Hall scored a season-high 24 points while his brother, sophomore C **Derek Hall**, added 15 points and six rebounds in 16 minutes off the Albright bench. In that game, Albright shot 60.4 percent (32-for-53) from the field and hit 10-of-21 shots from beyond the three-point arc... Albright is 8-2 at home and 4-5 on the road.
