About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays suffered their third straight close loss when Widener picked up a 66-62 victory on Saturday afternoon. Elizabethtown led by as many as five points in the second half, but the Pride broke the final tie of the day with 4:25 left and went on to the victory. Junior C **Mike Church** led the Blue Jays with 11 points, but was the only player to reach double figures as Elizabethtown shot 45.6 percent from the field as a team... Last Tuesday, the Blue Jays played at Messiah and nearly erased a 17-point deficit in the final 16 minutes before falling 67-64. A strong effort by the Blue Jay bench was led by 11 points from first-year G **Kyle McConnell** and nine points each from junior G **Chris Jones** and first-year F **Brian Allport**... Sophomore G **Keith Fogel** has made his last 27 foul shots since the Millersville game on Dec. 3, but has failed to get to the line in six of the last seven games... Sophomore F **Joe Flanagan** was held without a three-pointer for the first and only time this season against Albright on Jan. 31, going 0-for-5 from behind the arc... Senior G **Phil Schaffer** had a season-high seven rebounds and matched his season high with nine assists against Widener... Flanagan ranks fifth in the Commonwealth Conference in scoring average (14.2 ppg) and three-point percentage (.414).

About Lycoming...

The Warriors overcame an early 10-point deficit to defeat Arcadia 82-66 on Saturday afternoon, as four players scored in double figures. Lycoming outscored the Knights 44-29 in the second half and shot 51.9 percent from the field for the game, including 10-for-22 from three-point range. Senior F **Greg Sye** led Lycoming with 19 points and seven rebounds while junior G **Eric Anthony** tallied 17 points and four assists... Sye was named the Commonwealth Conference Player of the Week after averaging 18.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while shooting 81.2 percent (13-for-16) from the field... Anthony is third in the Commonwealth Conference in scoring (15.9 ppg), while Sye is sixth at 14.1 points per contest. Anthony also ranks second in free throw percentage (85.1 percent) with Sye second in field-goal percentage at 54.8 percent... Lycoming has played strong defense this season, allowing an average of 60.7 points per game that is eight points fewer than the next-best team. The Warriors also lead in field goal percentage defense at 40.8 percent... Anthony was a first-team All-Conference selection last season while Sye was a second-team pick. Former head coach Don Friday was named conference Coach of the Year, then departed to become head coach at Division I St. Francis (Pa.).
