About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays clinched their first Commonwealth Conference playoff appearance since 2005-06 with a 78-74 victory at Lebanon Valley on Saturday afternoon. Sophomore G/F **Joe Flanagan** led the Blue Jays with 22 points, including four foul shots in the final minute to clinch the win. Sophomore G **Keith Fogel** added 17 points and connected on the go-ahead three-pointer with 2:22 to play, while junior C **Mike Church** finished with 11 points and 10 rebounds and hit a pair of foul shots with 4.5 seconds left to ice the victory... Flanagan was named Commonwealth Conference Player of the Week for the second time this season after averaging 21.0 points in wins over Lycoming and Lebanon Valley. Flanagan scored a game-high 20 points in the win over Lycoming last Wednesday... Widener has clinched the top seed in next week's Commonwealth Conference playoff tournament, while Albright has locked up the second seed. If Elizabethtown wins today and Messiah loses at home to Widener, the Blue Jays will be seeded third and will play at Albright next Wednesday night in a semifinal game. Should Etown lose or Messiah win, the Blue Jays will be the fourth seed and will play at Widener on Wednesday evening... Senior G **Phil Schaffer** will be honored today prior to his final regular-season home game.

About Arcadia...

The Knights saw their slim conference playoff hopes come to an end on Tuesday night when Albright came away with a 72-67 victory. Arcadia trailed by 12 points in the first half, but took a brief two-point lead early in the second half and got to within three points in the final minute before the Lions put the game away at the foul line. Junior G **Damien Palantino** led the Knights with a game-high 21 points, including four three-pointers, while senior G **Bobby Mulholland** added 14 points and first-year G **Khalief Trawick** chipped in with 13 points and a team-high eight rebounds... The Knights have lost five in a row since picking up a 70-62 victory at Messiah on Jan. 31 behind 19 points from Mulholland. Four of Arcadia's five losses during that span have come by seven points or less... Palantino leads the Commonwealth Conference in three-pointers per game (2.61) while his 60 three-pointers are second overall to Lebanon Valley's Kyle Enoch (61)... Arcadia has used the same starting lineup (Palantino, Mulholland, senior G **Blaise Pepitone**, senior F **Terrell Varnado** and sophomore F **Darrell Mills**) in all 11 conference games... The Knights won back-to-back games just once all season, defeating Penn State Hazleton 82-77 on Dec. 8 and Rutgers-Camden 65-54 on Dec. 10.
