About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays scored the game's last 12 points to defeat Widener 72-65 on Saturday afternoon. Senior G **Megan Romano** scored seven of her career-high 17 points during the run, which capped a comeback from a 15-point first-half deficit. Senior G **Megan Quinn** led the Blue Jays with 23 points and 10 rebounds, while junior F **Ali Jury** had a career day off the bench with nine points, seven rebounds and eight blocked shots in 22 minutes of action... The Blue Jays set season highs for points (72), field goals made (26) and blocked shots (12) against Widener... Quinn's double-double was her sixth of the season, while her 23 points were three shy of her season high of 26 set against Manhattanville on Nov. 22... Jury's eight blocked shots were the most for an Elizabethtown player since Shelley Parks had 12 rejections against Juniata on Feb. 2, 1983, a season in which she finished with a school-record 105 blocked shots... Off the bench, first-year F **Kelly Sauerzopf** averaged 11.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 blocks last week, finishing with eight points and five boards against Widener in 14 minutes of action... Junior G **Courtney Kofeldt** leads the Blue Jays with 26 blocked shots, followed by Quinn and sophomore G **Megan Strohman** with 22 each... Elizabethtown has won its last four games in which it has finished with more rebounds than the opposition.

About Lebanon Valley...

In a battle of conference unbeaten, Messiah downed Lebanon Valley 69-47 on Saturday afternoon in Annville. Sophomore F **Eryn Schultz** was the lone LVC player to reach double figures, tallying 11 points, while sophomore Gs **Andrea Hoover**, **Lori Lidlow** and **Suzie Noyes** each finished with eight points. The Dutchmen shot 37.5 percent from the field as a team and were outrebounded 38-25 by the Falcons. The loss snapped a four-game winning streak for Lebanon Valley... Lidlow leads the Commonwealth Conference in scoring average at 16.6 points per game, and has drilled 20 three-pointers. Lidlow, a first-team All-Conference pick and Co-Rookie of the Year last season, had scored in double figures in every game for the Dutchmen this season before Saturday... Noyes returned to action at the beginning of January following an offseason injury, and has scored in double figures four times in six games including an 18-point, 11-rebound effort in a 65-60 win over Lycoming last Wednesday night... Hoover ranks second in the conference in assists per game at 5.36 (75 in 14 games)... Schultz, who leads the team with 34 three-pointers, tied the program record with six three-pointers (in seven attempts) in the Dutchmen's 67-42 win at Arcadia on Jan. 7.
