About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays lost at Dickinson 80-72 on Thursday night in a non-conference game, despite a career-high 28 points from senior G **Megan Quinn**. Quinn hit four three-pointers in the game, and became the fifth player in program history to make 100 career treys with her first of the night. First-year Fs **Kelly Sauerzopf** and **Stephanie Ellwood** each added 11 points for the Blue Jays, who saw the host Red Devils go 21-for-22 from the foul line... On Monday, Elizabethtown defeated Immaculata 82-66 as junior G **Courtney Kofeldt** set a school record with eight three-pointers and scored a career-high 24 points. The Blue Jays made 14 three-pointers as a team to tie the school record set against Lycoming last season. Kofeldt made her last seven three-point attempts in the game, after going 4-for-4 in her previous game against Arcadia last Saturday... Quinn leads the Commonwealth Conference in rebounding at 8.9 rebounds per game, and is second in scoring at 15.7 points per game, just behind Lori Lidlow of Lebanon Valley (15.8 ppg)... The Blue Jays have made 117 three-pointers as a team this season, tops in the Commonwealth Conference and eight shy of the program record of 125 made during the 2001-02 season... In the Blue Jays' last nine games, the team with the most rebounds also won the game. Elizabethtown is 5-4 during that span.

About Albright...

The Lions defeated Arcadia 76-45 on Wednesday night at home, as a balanced attack was led by 15 points from sophomore G **Jessica McGinness**. Senior G **Bre Dillon** added 11 points to move within 35 points of reaching the 1,000 milestone for her career. As a team, Albright shot 48.2 percent (27-for-56) and harassed the Knights into 27 turnovers... Last Saturday, Albright traveled to Lycoming and came back to Reading with a 78-63 victory as Dillon scored a game-high 22 points and dished out seven assists. Senior Gs **Annie McMahon** and **Charlotte Ciccone** added 17 points apiece for the Lions... Dillon ranks third in the Commonwealth Conference in points per game (14.9) and is tops in assists per game with an average of 5.5 per contest (99 in 18 games). She also ranks fourth in both free-throw (75.0) and three-point (40.4) percentage... Last season, Albright set a program record with 20 victories and qualified for the NCAA Division III tournament for the first time in school history, falling to Mount St. Mary (N.Y.) by a 75-62 score in the opening round... McMahon was a first-team All-Conference pick last year, while McGinness was a second-team choice and shared Rookie of the Year honors with Lori Lidlow of Lebanon Valley.
