# Elizabethtown College vs. Lycoming College • 2/11/09

## About Elizabethtown...

The Blue Jays were bounced 57-43 at Widener on Saturday afternoon, as the host Pride scored 13 of the game's final 15 points to break open a contest that stood at 44-41 with 5:30 to play. Senior G **Megan Romano** led Elizabethtown with 14 points, but the Blue Jays shot just 21 percent (13-for-62) from the field overall in the game, including 5-for-30 in the first half. First-year F **Stephanie Ellwood** added nine points and 10 rebounds while senior F **Jenn Montague** finished with a team-high 11 rebounds, the eighth time this season she has reached double figures... Elizabethtown made a season-low three three-pointers against Widener... The Blue Jays have continued a trend in which the team with the rebounding advantage has won each of the last 13 games... With three regular-season games remaining, Quinn is 36 points away from becoming the 23rd player in program history to record 1,000 points. She has scored 12 or more points in a game 14 times this season... Quinn continues to rank second in the Commonwealth Conference in scoring (15.2 points per game), rebounding (8.0 rebounds per game) and steals (2.50 per game)... Romano is third in the conference in foul shooting at 77.6 percent, making 22 of her last 24 attempts at the line over the last nine games... Junior G **Courtney Kofeldt** is tied for third in the conference with 47 three-pointers.

## About Lycoming...

The Warriors put four players in double figures and led by 30 points at halftime on their way to a 90-56 victory over Penn State Hazleton on Monday night. None of Lycoming's starters played more than 15 minutes in the rout, with senior G **Andrea Cooper** leading the way with 17 points and four assists. As a team, the Warriors shot 52.6 percent (41-for-78) and held a 41-23 advantage in rebounding... It was the second straight blowout win for Lycoming, which handled Arcadia 57-38 at home last Saturday as junior G **Allison Mock** nailed four three-pointers and finished with 14 points. The Warrior defense held the Knights to 24.1 percent (13-for-54) from the field in the contest... Lycoming has won three straight games since a tough 70-69 home loss to Lebanon Valley on Jan. 31 when the Dutchmen scored the winning basket with 4.4 seconds remaining... Mock leads the Commonwealth Conference in free-throw shooting at 89.8 percent (44-for-49) and is second in three-pointers made with 53 in 20 games (2.65 per game)... Junior F **Rebecca Leid** is tops in the conference in field-goal percentage at 56.8 percent (54-for-95) while sophomore F **Kaitlyn Ober** is ranked seventh at 47.9 percent... Head coach **Christen Ditzler** is three wins shy of 200 for her career.
