

**FIRST YEAR STUDENT ADVISING SHEET**

MAJOR:     **Accounting**

**COURSES REQUIRED BY MAJOR**

First Year (either semester)

- BA101 Global Issues in Business and Society
- AC101 Introduction to Accounting
- EC101 Principles of Macroeconomics or  
EC102 Principles of Microeconomics
- BA171 Business Orientation (1 cr)

**NOTES:**

1. Students may take EC101 and EC102 in any sequence.
2. CS120 is not required as part of the accounting curriculum, but students who do not feel comfortable with their computer skills (Microsoft Excel in particular) are strongly encouraged to take this course in their freshman or sophomore year.
3. AC 205 and AC206 should be taken in sequence normally beginning the fall of sophomore year.
4. MA251 should be taken in the sophomore year. Students should take any necessary prerequisites in the first year depending on their math placement.
