NOTES:

- 1. It would be best for students to take BA101 in the fall term.
- 2. Students may take EC101 and EC102 in any sequence.
- 3. MA251 is required in the sophomore year. Students should take any necessary prerequisites in the first year depending on their math placement.
- 4. BA270 and BA271 are to be taken in the 2nd year. Students should take BA270 in the fall and BA271 in the spring term.
- 5. BA205, BA305, and BA405 are sequence courses that should be taken following BA105 in the first year. Students would take BA205 in the 2nd year, BA305 in the 3rd year, and BA405 in the 4th year.
