

## FIRST YEAR STUDENT ADVISING SHEET

Major: French (Modern Languages)

First Semester (according to placement exam):  
French 111, 112, 211 or 303

Second Semester:  
French 112, 212 or 311

### NOTES:

1. All students with more than **two years** of French at the high school level must take the online language placement exam before registering in a French course for academic credit, unless the student is beginning a new language.
2. To fulfill the major, students must complete 35 hours above the 112 level.
3. Unless they have advanced placement, majors are required to take French 211, 212, and two 300 level courses. At least two of these courses must be taken at Elizabethtown College. In addition, students must also complete a 4 credit senior research project (FR 496/7).
4. A minimum of 15 credits in French must be taken in a study abroad program, such as BCA. Specific course requirements to be taken abroad are outlined on the language check sheet. Majors are expected to spend two semesters of study abroad. However, in exceptional cases, as specified in the college catalog, double-majors may apply for a waiver of one semester.
5. It is recommended that students complete the two 300 level courses before the study abroad experience.
