##### First Semester

##### Second Semester

#### NOTES:

1. 8 credits in one primary instrument or voice are required. Students whose primary instrument is not piano or organ should enroll in MU117 first semester and MU 118 second semester. Students whose primary instrument is piano or organ should enroll in MU111 first semester.
2. Students in the music program should be in an ensemble in the freshman year. Three credits of ensemble are required in the four years. Students interested in concert choir must audition.
3. Students are encouraged to take their creative expression requirement in a non-music course.
4. Other department requirements can be found in the Music Department Handbook.
5. Competency through the 112 level of a modern language is required.
6. All first year students are to enroll in MU100B in the fall semester.
