Lecturer of Accounting Business Department

The Elizabethtown College Department of Business invites applications for a full-time Lecturer in Accounting, effective fall 2016.

The position requires CPA licensing along with a Masters in Accountancy, Masters in Business Administration, Masters in Taxation or a Juris Doctor. Ideal candidates will have extensive experience in public accounting or in accounting management in the government or private sector. Candidates for the position must demonstrate potential for excellence in teaching and a willingness to engage students in scholarship, research and/or creative work.

Responsibilities include teaching 6 courses annually (24 credit hours) in accounting, including Introductory Accounting and, depending on the candidate's area of expertise, at least 2 of the following: Advanced Accounting, International Accounting, Taxation, Auditing or Personal Finance. Support for the mission of the college and involvement in faculty governance, student advising and new student recruitment are also expectations. Successful lecturers demonstrate a commitment to excellent, innovative teaching and professional development.
