PREMIUM DOUBLE – A premium double houses one student in a double room and offers the occupant extra square footage to live, study, and relax. There is an additional charge for a premium room.

You may apply for this option on the Residence Life website beginning March 7.

TRIPLE— A triple room houses three students and offers the occupants extra square footage to accommodate three people. Triple rooms are assigned based on lottery number and there are a limited number available. Please have a back-up plan in case your group is not accepted.

You may apply for this option on the Residence Life website beginning March 7.

BLOCK HOUSING—Block Housing is for larger groups of students who wish to select several traditional double rooms together. Block housing is assigned by lottery number and is limited. Please have a back-up plan in case your group is not accepted.

You may apply for this option on the Residence Life website beginning March 7.

SINGLE – A single room houses one student. Priority is given to students who have accommodations through Disability Services. The room is furnished with a bed, a dresser, and a desk. There is an additional charge for a single room. This option is limited. Please have an alternative housing option in case you are not accepted.

You may apply for this option on the Residence Life website beginning March 7.

BRINSER SUITE (ILU) - A suite houses four students and offers students the ability to live in a more independent setting. There are four suites and all of them are located in Brinser Residence Hall. Each suite has two furnished bedrooms, a private bath and kitchen, and furnished living and dining rooms. The suites are upperclassmen housing so only rising juniors or seniors can apply to live in a suite. There is an additional charge for a suite.

You may apply for this option on JayWeb beginning March 7.

APARTMENT OR QUAD (ILU) – An apartment or quad houses four students and offers students the ability to live in a more independent setting, whether in a gender neutral unit or in a traditional single-sex unit. Each has two furnished bedrooms, a full kitchen and bath, and furnished living and dining rooms. The apartments and quads are upperclassmen housing, so only rising juniors and seniors can apply. There is an additional charge for an apartment or quad.
