STUDENT JOB DESCRIPTION: Seeking energetic, hard-working students to join the **Summer 2014 Paint Crew** to assist with interior and exterior painting. **Must be available for summer work session which begins on May 19 and ends on August 23.** Experience with surface preparation, brushwork, and rolling paint is required.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

- Occasionally required to stand for long/extended periods of time.
- Regularly required to move about.
- Regularly required to climb stairs and/or ladders.
- Regularly required to maintain balance while walking, standing, crouching, or running.
- Occasionally required to reach up and out with hands & arms.
- Regularly required to talk and hear; verbally express information or instructions.
- Regularly required to use hands to grasp objects, type, pick up objects, move objects or hold objects.
- Occasionally required to lift up to 25 pounds and carry a distance of 10 feet.
- Occasionally required to push and/or pull up to 25 pounds a distance of 10 feet.

HOURS and/or HOURS PER WEEK REQUIRED: Daytime, 40 hours per week, Monday thru Friday.

PAY RATE: Hourly Rate (varies, depending on experience), **PLUS** Summer Housing & Meal Plan.

SPECIAL SKILLS NEEDED (for example—drivers license/van training, CPR, etc.):

- Ability to safely use power tools and/or hand tools is required.
