By the numbers since 1982, for the past 42 years, our Blue Jays have been awarded 21 Fulbright Scholarships, 30 Gilman Scholarships, 32 have been named Finnegan Fellows, 6 Goldwater Scholars, 5 Critical Language Scholars, 1 Davies Jackson Scholar (Cambridge University), 1 Rhodes Scholar (Oxford University). Will you be Elizabethtown College's next Rhodes Scholar, will you be awarded a Fulbright or a Goldwater, will you study abroad as a Gilman Scholar or join the list of 5 Blue Jays awarded a Critical Language Scholarship? Prestigious Scholarships and Fellowships are highly competitive awards sponsored by the U. S. Department of State and International Universities to fund American students to study, work, and serve abroad. The concept is called "Citizen Diplomacy" where American undergraduate and post graduate students, from all academic disciplines, study and serve abroad establishing relationships to bolster international relations and American diplomacy, consistent with our motto: "Educate for Service."

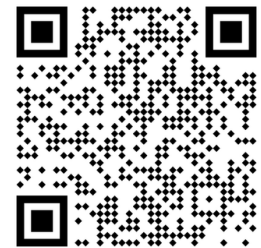
