Psychology Minor Curriculum

The Psychology minor requires 20 credits (5 courses). Students must complete PSY 105 plus 16 additional credits (4 additional courses) with the PSY or NEU prefix. Among the 20 credits for the minor, at least 4 credits (1 course) must be at the 300-level or above.
