How to use Starfish?

After you are registered for courses, you can access Elizabethtown College's Starfish system by clicking [here](#) or by visiting the "Academics" section of the Current Student Gateway page on the etown.edu webpage and selecting the "Starfish" link.

How to set up your profile and send your letter of introduction to your FYS Advisor & Peer Mentor

1. [Log in](#) with your Etown email and password.
2. Click on the Menu button  on the top left of your screen and select the arrow next to your name to edit your profile
3. Upload a photo of your face and enter any other information you'd like to update (pronouns, alternate email, phone, etc.)
4. To send your letter, from the Menu, click the "**Raise your hand**" button.
5. Select the "Letter of Introduction" option towards the bottom and leave the "**No Course**" option in the "**Course**" drop down

box. In the text box provided, enter your letter of introduction to your FYS Advisor & Peer Mentor. (Tell them about your interests, hobbies, strengths, what makes you excited about E-town, career aspirations, if you're transferring to Etown include any details about your previous college experience, etc.)

6. Click the Submit tab to send the notification.
