**The Geneva program: Team projects across the Atlantic

The Geneva study tour is intended to provide students an understanding of international organizations, primarily the United Nations, European Union and World Trade Organization. In spring 2018, Elizabethtown College students were placed in teams with students from a German university and a business school in Barcelona. Each team was assigned to work on a project. The collaborative work began in the spring, with online discussions and Zoom sessions. In May the groups from Elizabethtown, Konstanz and Barcelona met in Geneva to kick off the study tour, visiting various organizations and getting to know each other. Towards the end of the program, all three groups traveled to the university in Konstanz, where the teams made final presentations. The project thus sought to promote collaboration and teamwork across universities in various countries, and provided students an opportunity to think critically about pressing global issues, learn from each other, and hone their presentation skills.

Learning Outcome(s): The benefits and costs of team projects involving students from various countries.
