


Instructions for Ordering a Tax Return Transcript or Using the Data Retrieval Tool on the FAFSA

If selected for verification, federal regulations require transferring your income tax information by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool available on the FAFSA website at <https://fafsa.ed.gov/> or by submitting Tax Return Transcripts to Elizabethtown College.


How to Request a Tax Return Transcript Online:

1. Go to <https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript>

- access to your email account,
- your credit card number or account number from an auto loan, mortgage, home equity loan or home equity line of credit, and
- a mobile phone with your name on the account.

3. Click Get Started under First Time Users.
4. Read the registration information and click Continue.
5. Confirm that you have the required personal information available and click Yes.

- Tax filing status
- Current address

6. Confirm that you have the account number from a financial account listed on your credit report and click Yes.



You need a financial account to register

To verify your identity, we will need a number from ONE of your financial accounts. We can use any of the following:

- Credit Card **OR**
- Mortgage or Home Equity Loan **OR**
- Home Equity Line of Credit **OR**
- Auto Loan

You will only need to provide the loan account number or a few digits from a credit card number. We only use this information to verify your identity. **You will not be charged any money and are not sharing any account balances or other financial information with us.**

A soft inquiry will show up on your credit report to let you know that the IRS accessed your credit report information. This will not increase or decrease your credit score and lenders will not be able to see this.

If you have placed a credit security freeze with Equifax, you must contact Equifax to have the freeze temporarily removed before continuing. Once registration is complete, you may contact Equifax to resume the freeze.

Do you have this financial information available? (If you don't have the account information on hand, you should answer 'No'.)

7. Confirm that you have a mobile phone number and click Yes.
8. Enter your First Name and Last Name as they appear on your most recent tax return. Then enter your e-mail address and click Send Code.

9. The IRS will e-mail you an 8-digit code.
10. Enter your personal information and address information and click Continue.
11. Enter the account number for one of the choices listed and click Continue.
12. Enter your mobile phone number and click Send Message.
13. The IRS will text you a 6- digit code. Enter the code and click Continue.
14. Create your User Profile by entering a username and password. Then enter a phrase and select an image that you will recognize. Then click Continue.
15. After your user profile is created click Continue.
16. Read the Security Announcement and click Continue.
17. Select Higher Education/Student Aid from the drop down list and click Go.
18. In the Return Transcript box, click the year for the tax return transcript you want to download.

Glossary

Return Transcript
Tax Return Transcripts show most line items from your tax return (Form 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ) as it was originally filed, including any accompanying forms and schedules. This transcript does not reflect any changes you, your representative or the IRS made after you filed your return. In many cases, a Return Transcript will meet the requirements of lending institutions offering mortgages and student loans.

Record of Account Transcript
Record of Account Transcripts combine the information from tax account and tax return transcripts.

Account Transcript
Tax Account Transcripts provide any adjustments either you or we made after you filed your return. This transcript shows basic data, including marital status, type of return filed, adjusted gross income and taxable income.

How to Request a Tax Return Transcript by Phone

- Available from the IRS by calling 1-800-908-9946
- Tax filers must follow prompts to enter their Social Security number and the numbers in their street address.
- Select Option 2 for Tax Return Transcript request and enter the year you are requesting.
- If successfully validated, you can expect to receive the IRS Tax Return Transcript at the address that was used in the telephone request, within 5-10 days from the time the IRS receives the request.

How to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the FAFSA:

If any of the following statements are applicable, you are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool; therefore, you must submit a Tax Return Transcript to Elizabethtown College.

- My tax filing status is Married Filing Separately
- I filed an Amended Tax Return
- I filed a Puerto Rican or foreign tax return

IRS Data Retrieval Process

The IRS Data Retrieval Tool is not available until two weeks after submitting your tax return electronically or up to eight weeks after submitting a paper tax return to the IRS.

Help and Hints

Did you file your taxes electronically in the last 3 weeks (or by mail in the last 11 weeks)?

If you filed your taxes electronically within the last three weeks, or by mail within the last eleven weeks, select **Yes**; otherwise, select **No**.

If you filed your taxes within either of those timeframes, then your tax return information might not be available from the IRS. You can attempt to use the [IRS Data Retrieval Tool](#); however, if you are not able to transfer your tax return information into your FAFSA at this time, you can try again in a week or two or you can manually enter your tax return information.

5. If you are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, you can now click on the LINK TO IRS button. If you are not eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, follow the instructions above to order a tax return transcript by phone, online at IRS.gov, or by mail.
6. Click “OK” to leave the FAFSA website and enter the IRS Data Retrieval Tool website.
7. Click “OK” to accept the IRS Data Retrieval Tool terms of use.

8. Enter the requested information and click “Submit.” Remember to enter your address exactly as it appeared when you filed your taxes.

How to Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the FAFSA

The IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) allows students and parents who filed a U.S tax return with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to access the IRS tax return information needed to complete the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA®) form and to transfer the data directly into their FAFSA form.






