Please answer the following questions:

- Yes No Have you ever had a positive tuberculosis skin test or IGRA blood test?
- Yes No Have you had close contact with anyone known/suspected to have active TB disease?
- Yes No Were you born in one of the countries or territories listed below*?
- Yes No Have you had a stay of one month or more in any of the countries listed below*?
- Yes No Have you been a resident and/or employee of a high-risk congregate setting (for example: correctional facility, long - term care facility or homeless shelter)?
- Yes No Have you been a volunteer or health care worker who served clients who are at increased risk of active tuberculosis disease?
- Yes No Have you ever been a member of any of the following groups that may have an increased incidence of latent or active TB disease: medically underserved, low income, or those abusing drugs or alcohol?
- Yes No Do you have a history of immune suppression due to illness or medications?
- Yes No Do you have a history of BCG vaccination? (history of BCG isn't a contraindication to TB testing)
- Yes No Do you have signs/symptoms of active pulmonary Tuberculosis? (Cough>3 weeks, with or without blood, chest pain, unexplained weight loss, fevers, night sweats, loss of appetite).

If the answer to any of the above questions is YES, Elizabethtown College requires that you receive a PPD/Mantoux TB skin test or Interferon Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) blood test as soon as possible, but at least 6 months prior to the start of the semester. Chest x-ray is required for anyone with a history of a positive tuberculosis skin or blood test.
