



Adjunct Instructor in Quantitative Methods

The Department of Business at Elizabethtown College invites applications for an adjunct position in Quantitative Methods to begin in August 2019 and to possibly continue into future semesters depending on staffing needs. Applicants able to teach a Quantitative Methods course are encouraged to apply. The course is foundational, 200-level, and covers topics such as the following: decision analysis, forecasting, inventory management, materials requirement planning (MRP), and operations management concepts of enterprise resource planning (ERP), just-in-time (JIT), LEAN operations, and maintenance and reliability.

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The department offers B.S. degrees in: Accounting, Business Administration, International Business, Finance, Financial Economics, Marketing, and Business Data Science, and a B.A. degree in Economics. The Dept. of Business provide students with cutting-edge business skills, a personalized learning experience, and strong ties with the business community.
