



Assistant Professor in Statistics

Elizabethtown College invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor in Statistics. The goal of this position is to strengthen our new Data Science program. Applicants with expertise in all areas of statistics and data science will be considered.

The Department of Mathematical Sciences has seven full-time faculty members; offers majors in Mathematics, Actuarial Science, and Mathematical Business; and supports a Data Science major that is housed in the Department of Computer Science.

Applicants must be committed to undergraduate teaching in a liberal arts setting.

Applicants with expertise in all areas of statistics and data science will be considered and we are especially interested in applicants who can contribute to our new Data Science major by designing and teaching courses in Statistical Learning and Big Data. Teaching load is 12 contact hours per semester and may also include introductory and intermediate level Statistics courses. Interest in supporting our Data Analytics minor and knowledge of SAS is a plus. Candidates are expected to demonstrate an ability to remain current in the field by maintaining an active research agenda. Successful candidates will also be expected to advise students and mentor undergraduate research projects and to engage in departmental and Institutional service.

Graduate degree in Statistics, Data Science, or a related field. Ph.D in Statistics, Data Science or a related field preferred. Candidates with an earned doctoral degree will be considered for a tenure-track assistant professor position. Candidates with a master's degree and extensive industry experience are also invited to apply; they will be considered for a full-time lecturer position. Extensive background in statistics or data science is desired.
