



## Assistant Professor in Computer Science

The Department of Computer Science at Elizabethtown College invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Computer Science beginning July 1, 2019 with teaching responsibilities starting in Fall 2019. The Computer Science Department has five full time faculty and offers majors in Computer Science, Data Science, Computer Engineering (ABETaccredited) and Information Systems.

The successful candidate will demonstrate potential for teaching excellence, engage in scholarly work in their field, be eager to mentor undergraduates in research, participate in departmental academic advising, and contribute to service in the department and across campus.

Teaching will include introductory Computer Science courses and upper-level courses in their area of expertise. Candidates are expected to demonstrate an ability to remain current in the field by maintaining an active research agenda. Applicants should have a Ph.D. in Computer Science, Computer Engineering, Information Systems, or a closely related field prior to the start date. Applicants with expertise in all areas of computer science will be considered with specific areas of importance including: software engineering, data science, mobile and web-based applications development, and natural language processing.
