## **Computer Science (Open Rank)**

Elizabethtown College invites applications for an open rank, tenure-track position in Data Science to begin in August 2018.

The successful applicant will have an extensive background in data science, data analytics, or machine learning and will play a central role in the development a newly created Data Science major housed in the Computer Science Department. Applicants must have a graduate degree (Ph.D. preferred) in Computer Science, Statistics, Data Science, or some other field that has required significant experience analyzing data. Applicants must have the ability to design and deliver a variety of data mining, machine learning, and big data courses. Teaching may also include introductory and database systems courses in Computer Science. Preferred candidates will further demonstrate an ability to remain current in the field by maintaining an active research agenda or by engaging in regular consulting work. Successful candidates will also be expected to advise students, mentor undergraduate research projects, and work with underrepresented student populations.

The goal of this position is to build our Data Science program, so candidates will be considered at any rank, commensurate with experience. Plans for this program include an additional hire in the following year.

Review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled. To apply, candidates should submit a letter of application, the College's faculty information form, a CV, graduate transcripts (unofficial copies are acceptable), a teaching statement, and a research statement as well as three letters of reference. Applications will be accepted until the position is filled. Initial screening of applicants will begin **Friday, December 1, 2017**.
