

We are pleased and excited to announce that Elizabethtown College has become affiliated with the **Council of Independent Colleges (CIC)**. One benefit of this affiliation is that the College can offer our faculty and staff an additional tuition exchange site to which they can apply for college admission for their eligible dependents. This program supplements the Tuition Exchange Program that has been in existence for quite some time. CIC-TEP is a network of CIC member colleges and universities willing to accept, tuition-free, students from families of full-time employees of other participating institutions.

The CIC Program began some 30 years ago and has grown to include 423 participating colleges and universities. For those of you who have dependents considering college, this is another option for you as you apply to colleges through the Tuition Exchange Program. We suggest that you consider using both programs, the TE and the CIC to increase your possibilities.
