The Department of History at Elizabethtown College invites applications for a one-year Visiting Assistant Professor position in Modern Europe to begin July 2018.

Elizabethtown College particularly welcome candidates whose teaching and/or research interests take a diverse or global perspective. As well, we seek candidates whose expertise compliments, rather than duplicates, the department's existing strength in French history.

The Department is especially interested in attracting faculty committed to dynamic and innovative classroom instruction. The typical teaching load is 3-3, and faculty are expected to involve students in high-impact practices such as research and internships whenever possible. Qualified applicants will be committed to contribute survey courses to the College's Core Curriculum program as well as upper division sections in their specialty area.

A Ph.D. in History must be completed by summer 2018. A cover letter, CV and three letters of recommendation are required when applying for this position.
