

Elizabethtown College participates in the CLEP Program of the <u>College Board</u> accepting a score of 50 or higher in subject areas upon matriculation to the college.

- 1. All CLEP Exams must be completed prior to achievement of sophomore status (30 or more recorded college credits).
- 2. Up to 32 credits may be awarded for any combination of Challenge Examinations (AP, CLEP, IB, etc.) and none of the credits may duplicate College credits completed or enrolled in at the time of the examination. In order to fulfill Elizabethtown's Power of Language English Core requirement, the CLEP English Composition exam must be taken with the essay.
- 3. Letter grades are not assigned or calculated into the cumulative grade point average at Elizabethtown College, CLEP credits are accepted and recorded as transfer credits.
- 4. Currently enrolled students must receive written approval of the School Dean, governing the course discipline, and the Office of Registration and Records PRIOR to completing the examination. Any student with advanced knowledge in the CLEP subject will be prohibited from earning transfer credit through CLEP examination. Elizabethtown College reserves the right to deny transfer of credit for any examination without prior approval.
- 5. CLEP credits do not satisfy the residency requirement for graduation.
