STUDENT JOB DESCRIPTION: Seeking an energetic, hard-working student to join our **Summer 2018 Grounds Crew**. Must be available for summer work session which begins on May 14th and ends on August 17th. Experience with grounds maintenance, landscaping, mowing and use of hand tools is required. Must be willing to learn, follow instructions and be able to work outdoors all day.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

- Occasionally required to stand for long/extended periods of time.
- Regularly required to move about.
- Regularly required to climb stairs and/or ladders.
- Regularly required to maintain balance while walking, standing, crouching, or running.
- Occasionally required to reach up and out with hands & arms.
- Regularly required to talk and hear; verbally express information or instructions.
- Regularly required to use hands to grasp objects, type, pick up objects, move objects or hold objects.
- Occasionally required to lift up to 50 pounds and carry a distance of 10 feet.
- Occasionally required to push and/or pull up to 50 pounds a distance of 10 feet.

HOURS and/or HOURS PER WEEK REQUIRED: Daytime, 40 hours per week, Monday thru Friday.

PAY RATE: 8.25 per hour plus summer housing & meal plan.

SPECIAL SKILLS NEEDED (for example—drivers license/van training, CPR, etc.):
