
How will I pay for study abroad?

• Affiliated semester programs

- Tuition: Same as a normal semester at E-town
- Room and board: Paid to the study abroad provider or school, not E-town
- \$250 study abroad fee

Winter or summer programs, including faculty-led

- Responsible for the full cost of the program, because it's outside the academic year. No study abroad fee is required.
- \$250 study abroad fee (not required for faculty-led programs)
- International, tuition exchange and tuition remission students should consult the Financial Aid Office to discuss financing study abroad during the academic year, as your arrangements may be different.



Study Abroad Scholarships

- **E-town Study Abroad Scholarships**
 - Four \$1,000 semester scholarships
 - Four \$500 summer scholarships
- \$5,000 Gilman Scholarship
 - Federal Pell Grant recipients
 - Two chances to apply!
- **Critical Language Scholarship**
 - All expense paid summer program to study a language:
