How will I pay for study abroad?

Affiliated semester programs

- Tuition: Same as a normal semester at E-town
- Room and board: Paid to the study abroad provider or school, not E-town
- \$250 study abroad fee

• Winter or summer programs, including faculty-led

- Responsible for the full cost of the program, because it's outside the academic year.
- \$250 study abroad fee (not required for faculty-led programs)
- International, tuition exchange and tuition remission students should consult the Financial Aid Office to discuss financing study abroad during the academic year, as your arrangements may be different.

- Four \$1,000 semester scholarships
- Four \$500 summer scholarships
- \$5,000 Gilman Scholarship
 - Federal Pell Grant recipients
 - Two chances to apply!

Impactful Experience

- More than 160 E-town students study abroad each year, 10% of our overall student population
- Study abroad is continuously ranked of one of the top two most influential education experiences of our graduates
- Other alumni constantly say not studying abroad was one of the biggest regrets of their time at E-town
- In the past seven years, 16 E-town students and alums have been awarded Fulbright Scholarships all alums studied abroad during their undergraduate degree
