With its scholarship programs, the DAAD enables students, researchers and university lecturers to take advantage of the best study and research opportunities available. It promotes transnational cooperation and university partnerships, and is the German national agency for EU higher education cooperation. The DAAD actively supports Germany's foreign cultural and educational policy goals, national scientific policies and development cooperation efforts. In addition to overseeing the International DAAD Academy (iDA), the DAAD operates a network of 70 Regional Offices and Information Centers worldwide.

There are several scholarship opportunities available for all academic fields and on all academic levels. Grants usually cover the cost of living during the stay in Germany, and they often include a travel stipend.
