Global Grants provide funds for graduate-level study or research in another country. Students must pursue studies in one of Rotary's six Areas:

- Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution
- Basic Education and Literacy
- Water and Sanitation
- Maternal and Child Health
- Disease Prevention and Treatment
- Economic and Community Development

The minimum budget for a global grant project is \$30,000. The Foundation's World Fund provides a minimum of \$15,000 and maximum of \$200,000. Clubs and districts contribute District Designated Funds (DDF) and/or cash contributions that the World Fund matches. DDF is matched 100 percent and cash is matched at 50 percent.
