#### February-June

- Complete required forms in your <u>applicant portal</u> (listed under your Checklist)
- Register to attend June Orientation in your applicant portal
- Complete and submit your student health forms by July 1 but get started today!
- Complete your <u>FAFSA</u> and apply for <u>Outside Scholarships</u>

#### March-May

- Complete your scheduling forms in your applicant portal by May 25 (so we can build your fall schedule)
- Sign-in to your Financial Aid Student Aid Portal and submit outstanding documents

#### May

- Activate your Etown account/email (you'll receive an email from our IT team on May 5)
- Review your Financial Aid offer in your Financial Aid Student Aid Portal to accept or decline awards

#### June

- Submit your student health forms by July 1
- Residential students, complete your Housing forms by June 30 (you'll receive an email with instructions)
- Complete the Student Life required online modules by August 1 (you'll receive an email with instructions)
- Attend June New Student Orientation on June 27 or 28



## **Complete Forms for Fall Schedule Creation**

### High School Course Information form FYS Preferences form

### due May 26

During March-May, you'll complete forms sharing information about high school courses, dual enrolled courses, transfer credits, and more. We'll use this information to build your fall schedule.

You'll receive your fall schedule at June New Student Orientation. There will be opportunities to ask questions and make changes during June Orientation, as well as over the summer.



## **First Year Seminars**

You will take a First Year Seminar class during your first semester. Each Seminar has a different topic and will assist you in your transition to college. You'll rank your Seminar preferences in your status portal April-May.

Your First Year Seminar faculty member is your academic advisor for your first semester. You will transition to an advisor in your major during your second semester.

You will have a peer mentor who works with your First Year Seminar. Peer mentors are sophomores, juniors, and seniors who serve as a guide and mentor to you during your first semester at Etown. They can answer those questions that you just don't know who to ask.



# Weekly Emails: May-August 2 Tips on Tuesday

New students and families (if your student shared your email with us on their application!) will receive a weekly email from May-August with tips, to-do items, and much more.

If you didn't provide your family's email on your application, you can add it in the Contact & Demographic Info Form in your status portal.

**Be sure to check your email regularly!** 



# **Etown Email**

You will receive an email from our IT department on May 6 (if you deposited by May 1) or 2-3 days after you deposit (if you deposited after May 1) with instructions to set up your Etown account/email.

### Please set this up as soon as possible

Summer emails (from Orientation) will be sent to your personal email and Etown email Summer emails from Etown offices will be sent to your Etown email only Once classes start in August, all email will be sent to your Etown email only



# Housing Forms (residential students)

### Due June 30

**On May 9**, you will receive an email from our Residence Life team with instructions on how to complete your housing forms and request a roommate.

### If you don't have a roommate in mind, that's okay!

You may be able to find a roommate through our housing system. You can also meet your peers by joining the <u>Elizabethtown College Class of 2029 Accepted Students private Facebook group</u>. You may meet a student you'd like to room with at June Orientation. You can complete your roommate request after June Orientation.



# **Student Health Forms**

### **Due July 1**

### <u>Instructions</u> can be found on the <u>New Blue Jay To-Do List</u> You will also receive an email the week of **May 12** with instructions.

Completed forms should be uploaded to our health records portal by July 1. You must set up your Etown account before you can log into the health records portal.



### June Orientation: June 27 & 28

You will get your fall schedule, meet your Seminar faculty, peer mentor and peers, tour residence halls, learn more about Etown, and get your questions answered *Pick one day to attend (both are identical); parking is at Leffler Chapel* 









## What if I can't attend June New Student Orientation?

We will miss you, of course, but this is certainly fine! All new students will receive an email after June Orientation with information on how to access your schedule, as well as other important details (including recordings of most sessions).





# July & August: <u>New Blue Jay To-Do List</u>

#### July

- Apply for Parent Plus Loan or Private Loan if additional Financial Aid is needed for your student bill
- Enroll in or waive our student health insurance
- Understand <u>meal plans</u> for eating on campus
- Submit your tuition payment by August 1 (Learn how to set up your online payment account)
- Complete the Student Life required online modules by August 1 (you'll receive an email with instructions)
- Register your vehicle by August 10, if you're bringing one to campus (Parking Regulations)

#### August

- Complete your <u>New Student Tech Orientation</u>
- Residential students, check out our packing list
- Commuting students, learn more about <u>commuter student services</u>
- Complete your Preliminary Check-in process (you'll receive an email with instructions)
- Understand Inclusive Access course materials (online textbooks) & check your email for your course materials
- Share your <u>mailing address</u> with friends (mailbox number found in <u>Jayweb</u>: Housing-Campus Mailbox Info)
