Dr. Silberstein shares that "as an undergraduate student I was highly interested in a diversity of subjects and followed this curiosity wherever it led me. Consequently, I ended up graduating with multiple degrees in both the humanities and the sciences. Being a professor at Elizabethtown College has enabled me to continue to follow my curiosity for the past 30 years in ways that would not have been possible at most institutions of higher education. This presentation will take you down the 'rabbit hole' of my strange and improbable career in research and teaching."

Ranck Prize Background:

Robert O. Kerr '64 and Mary Ann Kerr '64 established the Ranck Prize for Research Excellence as a permanent endowment to award a full-time faculty member of Elizabethtown College and to commend and celebrate excellence in research and commitment to his or her field of study. The prize honors John P. Ranck '58, faculty member emeritus and former chair of the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry, for "his inspirational service to countless students at Elizabethtown College."


