Presenter, Dave Weiss: Dave is currently pastor of Springfield Church of the Brethren and incorporates the arts in his ministry. In addition to pastoral ministry, Dave presents programs using a unique combination of “speed painting” and storytelling which he calls “storypainting” to communicate the Gospel. He has written and/or illustrated 19 books including the soon to be released “The Imaginative Church.”

Through Dave’s leadership, we will explore creativity and the arts in three aspects of church ministry: Worship, Education, Outreach – or as Dave says, “Preaching, Teaching and Reaching.” Each aspect of ministry will have some teaching as well as hands-on/interactive projects. This workshop will stir creativity that is in all of us, even if we think we have none. Instruction will be based on Dave’s books: Ministering to the Creative Soul, and The Imaginative Church.
