Schwarz Charitable Trust for Education – interest-free loans for undergraduate and graduate students who demonstrate exceptional academic performance and significant financial need. **Applications available in January. Deadline: April. (June: Loan Committee Annual Meeting. Applicants will be notified shortly thereafter.)**

Non-traditional Student Scholarships

- ❖ James L. Fritz/Charlotte W. Newcombe Scholarship for Mature Women and Men Students – endowed scholarship awarded annually to mature men or women, 25 years or older, on the basis of financial need, academic record and professional/career aspirations. For information, contact your academic advisor.
- ❖ Alpha Sigma Lambda Honor Society Scholarship – For current SCPS students pursuing an associate or bachelor's degree who have completed a minimum of 24 semester hours of graded coursework; achieved a minimum 3.2 GPA in all coursework; and have demonstrated financial need. For information, contact your academic advisor. **Deadline: May**
- ❖ J. Bernard Schmidt Scholarship – Five \$1,000 scholarships offered annually through the Dixon Center for students based at the Harrisburg location. Two scholarships awarded in fall, two in spring and one in the summer semester each year. **Deadline: April, August and November**

- ❖ [Adult Students in Scholastic Transition \(ASIST\)](#) – For adults living and/or attending college in the Harrisburg region. Must demonstrate a financial need, be socially, physically or economically disadvantaged adults, heads of households with small children, or displaced homemakers. To apply click [here](#). **Deadline: March 27**
- ❖ [LEBANON VALLEY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE Women in Business Non-Traditional Student Scholarship](#) – Open to women and men over 25 years old, or younger than 25 if a single parent/displaced homemaker. Must live and/or work in Lebanon County and be currently registered in a minimum of 6 credits during the semester. Award ranges from minimum \$750 to \$1,500. **Deadline: April 17**
- ❖ 50+ Festival Scholarship – for adults age 50 or older who reside in Lebanon County. For more information, contact your academic advisor.
- ❖ [Government Finance Officers Association Scholarships](#) – The GFOA offers scholarships of \$5,000+ which are available to undergraduate or graduate students of public administration, (governmental) accounting, finance, political science, economics or business administration (with a specific focus on government or nonprofit management.)
- ❖ [National Society of Accountants](#) – The NSA Scholarship Foundation awards \$500 - \$2,200 to undergraduates enrolled part-time or full-time in accounting at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the United States. **Deadline: April 1**
- ❖ [The Foundation for Enhancing Communities](#) – TFEC offers over 80 scholarships established by generous local individuals, corporations or organizations to assist students with their educational pursuits. **Deadlines vary by scholarship.**
- ❖ [Family and Children’s Services of Lebanon County](#) - Offered to Lebanon County residents in financial need who are pursuing an undergraduate degree in human services or social sciences. **Deadline: March 30.**
- ❖ [Abbott and Fenner Scholarship](#) - Scholarship award is up to \$1,000 each year. Students will submit an essay on the topic listed on the scholarship page of the website. **Deadline: June 12**
- ❖ [The SILA Foundation Scholarship](#) - The Securities and Insurance Licensing Association Foundation offers ten \$2,500 scholarships annually to business and accounting majors. Applications accepted after April 1. **Deadline: May 31.**
- ❖ [Student Loan Hero \\$5K Scholarship](#) - Student Loan Hero, an unbiased solution to organize, manage, and repay your student loans, awards two (2) \$5,000 scholarships each semester to help alleviate educational costs, along with four \$2,000 runner-up scholarships. **Deadline: April 24 and October 9**
- ❖ [The Hershey Federal Credit Union Richard E. Fogleman Memorial Scholarship](#) - Any HFCU member pursuing a post-secondary education is eligible to apply. Applicants will be judged on their scholastic and extracurricular activities, as well as a 200-word essay on how credit unions differ from banks. **Deadline: April 3**

Women's Scholarships

- ❖ [AAUW Higher Education Scholarship - Carlisle Branch](#) - Awards \$1,500 scholarship to a female candidate who fulfills the following qualifications: must be a resident of

Cumberland County for at least a year; must have completed at least one year of study toward a two or four year degree at a regionally accredited institution.

Deadline: January

- ❖ [American Association of University Women - Harrisburg](#) – Various scholarships for women who are residents of Dauphin, Perry or Cumberland counties and are seeking degrees ranging from \$1,000 - \$2,500. **Deadline: July**
- ❖ [Edward and Carol Murphy/Charlotte Newcombe Scholarship for Mature Women Students](#)– endowed scholarship awarded annually to mature women, 25 years or older, on the basis of financial need, academic record, and professional/career aspirations. For information, contact your academic advisor.
- ❖ Elizabeth Hughes Society – for women 25 years and older who reside within the Elizabethtown Area School District. For information, contact your academic advisor.
- ❖ [Jeanette Rankin Foundation Scholarship](#) – financial need-based scholarship for women age 35 and older. **Deadline: February 27**
- ❖ [P.E.O. International](#) – Select P.E.O. *Program for Continuing Education* – provides monetary grants to women whose education has been interrupted and who find it necessary to resume studies due to changing demands in their lives.
- ❖ [Soroptimist International of Harrisburg - Women's Opportunity Award](#) – Eligible applicants must be female heads of household, who are enrolled in an undergraduate degree program in math, science, computer science or engineering. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and cannot have already earned an undergraduate degree. **Deadline: April 30**
- ❖ [Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarship](#)- awarded to women undertaking business studies who have demonstrated outstanding potential in the field. Open to women enrolled in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a Master's program at the time the application is submitted. Offered through the Harrisburg/Hershey chapter of Zonta International. For application, contact your academic advisor. **Deadline: May 1**
